BBA in Finance (Banking Concentration) – 120 Credit Hours

The BBA degree in finance with a banking concentration provides an in-depth study of state and federal regulatory agencies. For this degree, students complete 120 credit hours including the General Education Program (34 hours), the Business Core (27 hours), the Finance Major Core (12 hours), the Banking Concentration Core (15 hours), a set of Banking Concentration Electives (9 hours), related cognate courses (9 hours), and free electives (14 hours).
